Accepting Your Offer	<p>ALL APPLICANTS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To accept an offer of enrolment complete and return your Acceptance Form to the Graduate Research Office (GRO) within the time-frame stated. <p>INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A Confirmation of Enrolment for Overseas Students (CoE) will then be sent out to enable you to apply for a Student Visa to enter Australia. You should notify the Graduate Research Administration Officer and Supervisors of their approximate arrival date.
Living and Studying in Tasmania	<p>ALL APPLICANTS:</p> <p>Living and studying in Tasmania can be expensive compared to many parts of the world. We remind all applicants that if you are not successful in gaining an APA, IPRS or TGRS scholarship you must be in the position to support yourself for the full duration of your candidature. It is recommended that you have at least \$18,000 Australian Dollars per annum to live on.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> PART-TIME WORK: Tasmania is a small island state with limited employment opportunities. Do not rely on finding part-time work to help fund your candidature. (as a full-time candidate, you are only allowed to work a maximum of 8 hrs/week) ACCOMMODATION: It is the responsibility of the students to arrange for their own accommodation. <p>INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS:</p> <p>Please consult the Graduate Research International Student Guide for further information about living and studying in Tasmania - http://www.utas.edu.au/research/graduate-research/future-students/international-student-guide</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> See also the International Student Support Web Page - http://www.utas.edu.au/international-support
Flights and Airport Pick-up Request	<p>INTERNATIONAL and INTER-STATE APPLICANTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> It is your responsibility to book flights to arrive at the appropriate Tasmanian city (usually Launceston or Hobart). PLEASE NOTE: The main Faculty of Education base is Launceston. International Student Support can pick you up from the airport. Please complete the Airport Pick-Up Request Form at least 48 hours prior to your departure - http://www.utas.edu.au/international-support/forms/airport-pickup-request
