Dear Student

Congratulations on your enrolment into the Bachelor of Paramedic Practice (BPP).

The BPP is a full time fast track degree with teaching being delivered over three semesters:

Semester 1: February - June

Semester 2: July - October

Semester 3 (spring school extended): November – February

As part of your course you will need to attend a number of compulsory placements. The main placements are three Emergency Ambulance Placements (EAPs). These placements are likely to be with Ambulance Tasmania, however, there may be opportunities for interstate or overseas placements subject to availability of suitable placements and approval by the Course Coordinator. The first EAP is scheduled during Semester 3 of Year 1, the second in Semester 2 of Year 2 and the third placement will occur in Semester 3 of Year 2. Dates are dependent on availability of placements in the Ambulance Service.

In Tasmania, the EAP can occur in rural, urban and metropolitan areas. By accepting an enrolment into the BPP, students accept that there they will be required to undertake placement in more than one region. Students also accept that they will be responsible for transport to and from their placement and will be responsible for accommodation and travel costs during the placement.

Please note, placements are not transferable to other students (you cannot swap), nor are they negotiable once a placement had been arranged. Students are also advised they cannot arrange their own placements with AT, or any other Ambulance Service provider.

You have received all your compliance information for entry into this course. By signing below, you are also agreeing to submitting these requirements by the dates specified in your orientation handbook. Failure to do so will impact on your ability to complete placements which in turn affects your capacity to pass the unit.

By accepting your enrolment into the BPP you acknowledge the above placement and compliance conditions and agree to these.
