  - B Ordinal
  - C Interval

- 2) Identify the scale of measurement for grouping people according to their favourite colour.
  - A Nominal
  - B Ordinal
  - C Interval
  - D Ratio
- 3) Identify the scale of measurement for the following: heat measured in degrees Celsius.
  - A Nominal
  - B Ordinal
  - C Interval
  - D Ratio
- 4) City of birth is an example of:
  - A Nominal
  - B Ordinal
  - C Interval
  - D Ratio
- 5) Identify the scale of measurement for the following: heat measured in degrees Kelvin.
  - A Nominal
  - B Ordinal
  - C Interval
  - D Ratio

**Answers**

- 1) The answer is B. The scale is ordinal. For example the Commissioner is a higher rank than the Deputy Commissioner.
- 2) The answer is A. The scale is nominal. No particular colour is placed ahead of another.
- 3) The answer is C. The scale is interval. There are equal intervals between each temperature but there is no true zero point.
- 4) The answer is A. Nominal.
- 5) The answer is D. The scale is Ratio. There are equal intervals between each temperature and there is a true zero point.
