TUESDAY 17 DECEMBER 2019

All graduands have the opportunity to participate in the Ceremonial Town and Gown Parade even though your graduation is the following day. If you wish to participate the details are below.

10.00am: TOWN AND GOWN PARADE

Graduands assemble at the Institute for Marine and Antarctic Studies (IMAS) on Castray Esplanade. The march commences at **10.15am**. The procession (with police escort and band) will move along Castray Esplanade into Morrison St, turning right into the Elizabeth St intersection, onto Franklin Wharf, then left towards Constitution Dock, over Victoria Dock bridge, left onto Hunter St and crossing Davey St to the Federation Concert Hall; see [Town & Gown](#)

WEDNESDAY 18 DECEMBER 2019

9.00am: All Students to meet at the Medical Science Precinct, Level 1, MSP, 17 Liverpool Street for photo call. Graduands to attend in academic dress.

09:00am – 10:15am: Graduating Cohort 2019 Photos

Graduands attend in academic dress. Assemble in the external courtyard, outside Saludem Café (*where the photos are taken depends on the weather on the day – this may change*)

10:15am: PROCEED TO THE THEATRE ROYAL FOR THE DECLARATION OF GENEVA CEREMONY

Please make your way to the **Theatre Royal, 29 Campbell Street** as quickly as possible

10.30am – 11.00am: SCHOOL OF MEDICINE REPRESENTATIVES TO ADDRESS GRADUANDS re procedures for Declaration of Geneva Ceremony

11.00am: Declaration of Geneva Ceremony attendees family, friends arrive. Family and friends are welcome at this ceremony (tickets are not required – there is enough seating at the Theatre Royal for approx. 4 guests per graduand). **Theatre Royal, 29 Campbell Street, Hobart**

11.15am: Declaration of Geneva Ceremony attendees will need to be seated in the Theatre Royal by this time

11.15am – 12.15pm: DECLARATION OF GENEVA & ANNOUNCEMENT OF PRIZES

IMPORTANT NOTE: Graduands should make their own lunch arrangements prior to attending the Graduation Ceremony at 1.30pm. Prize recipients will have lunch to meet the Prize Donors after the ceremony concludes.

12.15pm – 1.15pm: PRIZE RECIPIENTS LUNCH WITH DONORS (Theatre Royal stage after ceremony finishes)

1.30pm: ARRIVE AT THE FEDERATION CONCERT HALL, HOTEL GRAND CHANCELLOR, 1 DAVEY ST

2.00pm: GRADUATION CEREMONY – Federation Concert Hall

3.30pm (approx): REFRESHMENTS AT THE HOTEL GRAND CHANCELLOR for all new graduated and their guests. Opportunity to get individual graduation photos and memorabilia
