Cautionary Advice Notice (CAN)

If there are concerns regarding a pre-service teacher's ability to complete the placement successfully, the school must complete a CAN and email it to the Professional Experience Coordinator as soon as possible during the placement. The pre service teacher must be given a copy of the form.

Once received by the Professional Experience Coordinator, a PE Leader will make contact with the relevant staff at the school to discuss the next steps and provide support to the student and the school through the remainder of the placement, which may include a visit to the site where possible.
