

What is the Competency Tool?

- Linking objectives to assessment items
- Tracking students against objectives
- Presenting students with their progression
- Releasing content based on progression
- Competencies across Units / Courses





Grading and the Competency Tool are independent tools!

- Essentially.... We are running two sets of books!






To grade or track objectives....that is the question

- VE Units to SMS








Creating Competencies

- Organisational or Space based
- Hierarchal Elements / Performance Criteria
- What.... No import!
- Pushed into Spaces, Colleges or Teaching Periods
- Evaluated across Spaces





















ePortfolio

- Submit presentations with objectives and 'evidence'





Requirements of VE

The Audit!

- Tracking engagement.
- Tracking evidence.
- Assessing against Elements / Performance Criteria / Range Statement.

Common Issues

- Over assessing.
- Not using a range of assessment methods.





Problems with grading VE in an LMS

- What numbers?..... That's not Competency!
- Creating an organisational scheme problematic
- Ensuring setup of GradeBook does not show final calculated mark
- Tracking which assessments relate to which Unit / Element.....
- Quizzes..... what am I assessing?





Not just for VE..... HE benefits

- Graduate Capabilities / AQF standards
- Across organisational tracking
- Students can contextualise attributes / capabilities gained
- Save to ePortfolio for CV / applications






Issues & future requests
