

## **ya pulingina - Welcome to the University of Tasmania**

As a visitor to our University, we have a responsibility to ensure your time with us is enjoyable and safe. You also have a role to play in helping us keep you and others safe while you visit.



### **General Information**

- ❖ Before visiting our campus, we ask that you monitor your symptoms and stay home if unwell.
- ❖ When you arrive on campus, please attend one of our Health Screening Stations where you will be asked some questions about your travel history, contacts and symptoms and have a non-contact temperature test.
- ❖ Sign in on the Visitor Register or register via the QR Code for each building you enter (this is important for contact tracing).
- ❖ Follow physical distancing requirements i.e. keep 1.5m distance between yourself and others.
- ❖ Practice good hand hygiene by washing your hands thoroughly or using hand sanitiser regularly during your visit.
- ❖ Please obey all signage, verbal directions, or printed instructions from university staff.
- ❖ Please observe all traffic signs and speed limits on all campuses.
- ❖ Understand that access to some areas of the University, such as laboratories and workshops is strictly controlled. An induction may be required before being allowed entry to these areas.
- ❖ Please observe the non-smoking requirements on all our university campuses.
- ❖ Do not bring pets or animals onto campuses unless they are an accredited or trained assistance animal or have been approved to be on campus through a supported risk assessment.
- ❖ If you notice a hazard while on campus, please report it to one of the key contacts below.
- ❖ If you become ill or are injured, please seek assistance from university staff or our University Security Services.
- ❖ In the event of an emergency, please follow emergency procedures and directions of staff.
- ❖ If you feel unsafe contact our University Security Services or use one of our Help Points that are located in key positions across our campuses.
- ❖ Our University does not tolerate harassment, bullying, victimisation, or discrimination. Please show respect and care for others.
